From the Principal and Deputy Principals' Desks



Dear Parents, Caregivers and Whanau,

Welcome back to Term 4. We hope that you had a lovely break from the routine of school and that you and your children are ready for another busy term. Term 4 is a busy term with lots of activities, so please keep an eye out for the calendar events and what is coming up.

School Leaders 2021 - We will be slightly changing the process for appointing our Year 7 students to be leaders for 2021. Traditionally we have announced these at the final prize giving assembly. This year we have decided that we will announce the shortlisted candidates for selection at the final prize giving assembly. These candidates will then undergo a further process during the induction day for new students at the beginning of 2021 and their attendance at Noho Marae in Maketu in March 2021. During this initiation and trial period all shortlisted candidates will be expected to display the desired qualities of a student leader.

Shortlisted candidates will attend the Noho Marae of all 3 Teams over a 10 day (9 nights) period where they will have the opportunity to demonstrate their leadership capabilities and also come together as a leadership team in preparation for the year ahead. Following the camp our Head Students will be announced along with the rest of the leadership team.

In the meantime students who wish to put their names forward for shortlisting should start getting their application ready. They apply to their teacher in the first instance by presenting a CV. They can either use our school CV template or design their own amazing application. A template, in English and in Maori, will be available to be collected from your child's teacher if they choose to use it.

Period Products - Kids Can have delivered a second pallet of products for our girls to collect. A "Girls Assembly" was held after assembly this week to remind girls that there are enough products available **FREE** for them for Every Cycle. We will have another delivery before the end of the term to provide products for girls over the Christmas Holiday period. Please help your girls to ask and collect these.

Enrolment - We urgently need any students planning on coming to Kaitao Intermediate in 2021 to get their enrolment forms to us. We need this information in order to be able to collect information from their contributing school and to make an appropriate classroom placement individually for each child. Early enrolment helps us to staff and resource the school well.

Athletics Day - We are really looking forward to our up and coming Athletics Day on Wednesday 4th November. We look forward to holding competitive and noncompetitive events that means full participation by everyone can take place. Students will earn points for their team, have fun with their peers and be able to show parents and whanau the athletics skills they have learnt during their PE sessions. We welcome you to attend and look forward to seeing you all here.

Uniforms - It is our expectation that school uniforms will be maintained and that all students will stay in full school uniform until the end of Term 4. We thank you for your support in getting a number of our students back into the habit of wearing the correct uniform each day.

Student Phones - Please be very aware that we take very seriously our policy and stance on student phones. The following needs to be understood by everybody in our school community. Students are **not under any circumstances allowed to have their phones on them during the school day**. Students who have a propensity to hurt other students often seek ways, including having fights to record these incidents on theirs or others phones and upload to social media. This happens very rarely but it is very upsetting to students, parents and teachers when it does happen. Students are allowed to bring phones to school but must hand them in at the office on arrival. Students will get into serious trouble firstly for not following these rules and then secondly videoing anything that is violent or degrading to others and uploaded to social media. Please as adults can you ensure you are very aware of these rules and support your children to also understand and comply with them one hundred per cent.

End of Term Date - The last day for Term 4, 2020 is Wednesday 16th December. Year 7 and new enrolments begin school on Tuesday 2nd February. Returning Year 8's begin their year on Wednesday 3rd February.

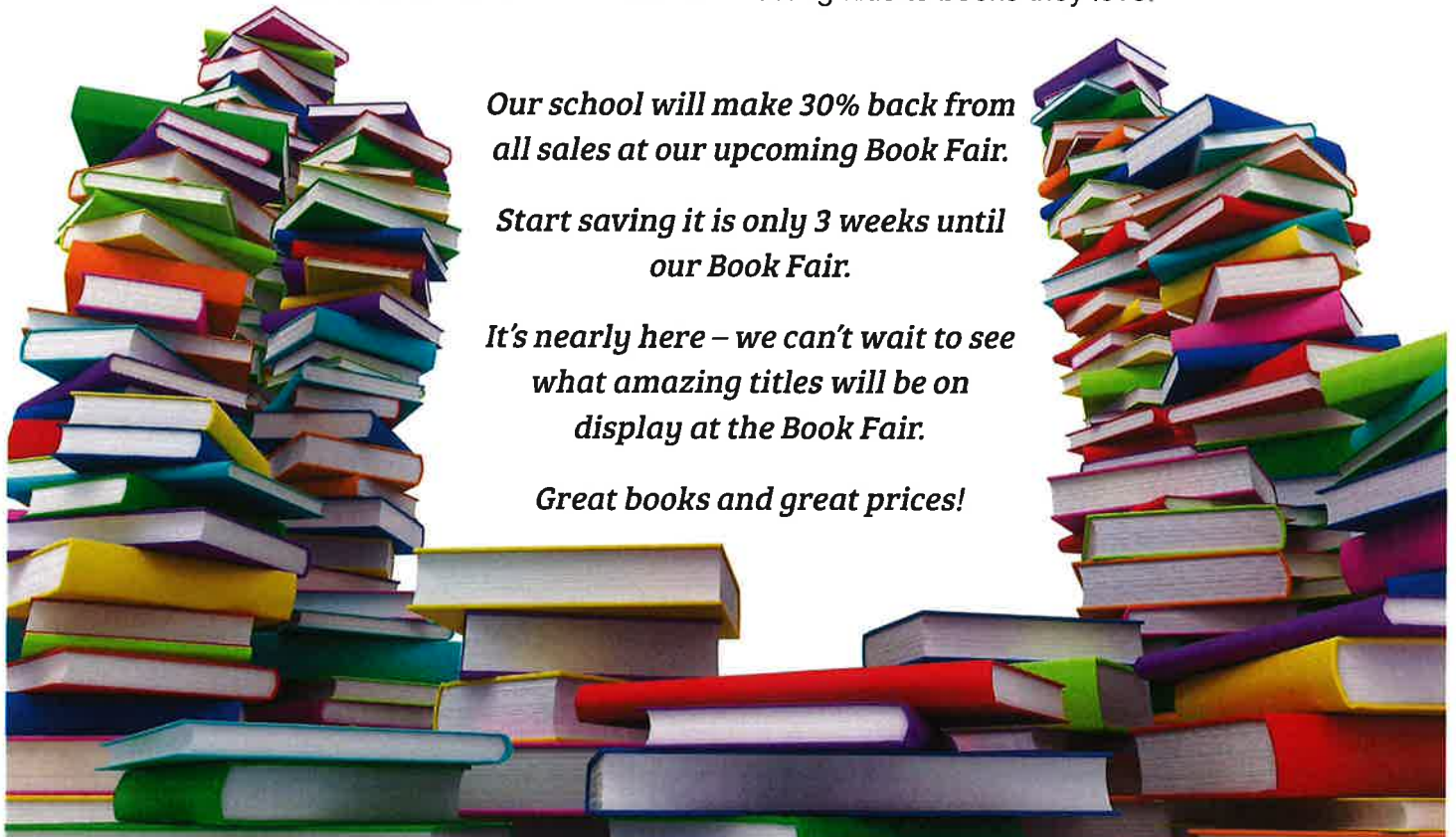

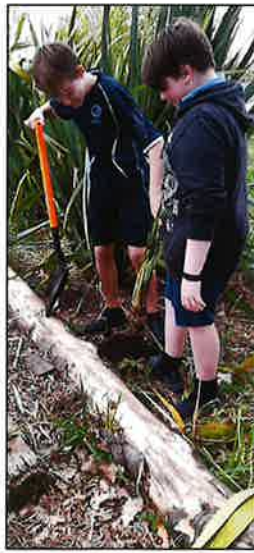
